Rainbow Wind Chimes - for Key Workers

Items you will need

- ✚ A dry, empty tin, i.e. beans, peas, soup
- ✚ Paint or coloured paper
- ✚ Strips of ribbon, wool or coloured paper
- ✚ String
- ✚ Glue

Top Tip

If you don't have strips of paper, then you can colour a rainbow and cut it out into strips.

Method

- ✚ Remove the label and paint a rainbow around the tin.
- ✚ Make a hole in the middle of the closed end. Please ask an adult to help you. *I used a screwdriver and hit it with a hammer*
- ✚ Thread some string through the hole and tie a knot
- ✚ Stick the strips of ribbon, wool or paper just inside the tin so they hang down.
- ✚ Now find somewhere to hang your wind chime up.
- ✚ These can be hung up outdoors or inside.

Leaf Rubbing

What you will need

- ✚ Paper
- ✚ A leaf of your choice. *The size and shape is up to you*
- ✚ Different coloured crayons/pencils



Method

- ✚ Place your leaf upside down so the spines are sticking up onto a hard surface. *This could be a piece of paper on top of a book or table.*
- ✚ Next lay a plain piece of paper over the top of the leaf. Now with your chosen coloured crayon rub hard over the top of the leaf working your way around the edges. *Try not to go too far away from the edge.*
- ✚ You can carry on with the same colours or stop at different points and change it so you make a rainbow and or pattern.
